Course description & objectives:

This course is designed to introduce students to the basic skills requisite for modern conversational Vietnamese. Our focus is communicative and the development of interactive speaking and listening skills is heavily emphasized, though training will be provided in all four basic language acquisition areas (speaking, listening, reading, and writing). Upon completion of this course, students will have mastered basic Vietnamese pronunciation (including all six contrastive tones), command of the basic grammatical structure of the language with a basic vocabulary geared toward daily conversation, and total command of the writing system (a romanized alphabet known as $Qu\acute{o}c\ Ng\~u$). No previous knowledge of Vietnamese is assumed. Finally, language instruction will be punctuated with intermittent exposure to Vietnamese culture and society, both ancient and modern.

Attendance and participation:

Attendance is mandatory, excepting illness with medical documentation, approved religious observances, or personal catastrophe (e.g. a death in the family). After the second unexcused absence, each unexcused absence will reduce your <u>overall grade</u> by 3%. Missing more than five sessions will result in failing the class.

Oral presentations

Students will be responsible for two oral presentations over the course of the semester: one as part of their midterm examination, and one as part of their final examination. The midterm oral will take the form of a presentation, skit, or video on topics provided by in class. The final oral examination will take the form of a brief interview with the instructor.

Homeworks

Homeworks will come in two forms: "checked" and "graded." "Checked" homeworks, assigned daily, will be graded on the following scale: \checkmark (10/10), \checkmark - if late or incomplete (7/10), or 0 (0/10). Graded homeworks consist of periodic assignments, and will be graded according to a normal A-F grading spectrum.

Guidelines for submission of written work:

- -All work must be word-processed (no handwritten work will be accepted).
- -Double-spaced, using 1-inch standard margins.
- -Use standard font (e.g. Times New Roman), in 12-point.
- -Number your pages.
- -Staple your pages together.
- -At the top of the first page include your name, assignment designation, date, and essay title.
- -Proofread and spellcheck before bringing any drafts to class.
